HONORING DORIS YAFFE

Fashion Icon | Citizen of the Globe | Advocate | Mentor | Connector

Doris Yaffe (July 1, 1929 - December 7, 2023) was more than a fashion icon—she was an impeccably dressed force of nature. A Boston native, she was born during the Great Depression, an era that shaped her resilience, creativity, and relentless spirit. From a young age, she understood the art of reinvention and the power of making something extraordinary out of whatever life handed you - an ethos she carried with her always.

Doris married, built a family with two wonderful sons, and cultivated deep friendships across the globe, all while embracing a life that was as colorful as the fashion she loved so deeply. She took her first job later in life, a move that was nearly unheard of for a married woman in midcentury America. At a time when societal

expectations dictated that women remained in the home, she defied convention.

She started her career at fashion retailer Sara Fredericks on Newbury Street before working with the celebrated designer Alfred Fiandaca, a MassArt alumnus and one of her closest lifelong collaborators. By the late 1960s, she had established herself as a powerhouse in the industry, eventually becoming Fashion Director at Saks Fifth Avenue, where she built a career that spanned decades.

Her influence was undeniable—she worked with luminaries from Chanel's Philippe Guibourge to a young Michael Kors, whom she famously consoled after an early career misstep. She was known for her keen eye, often discovering designers before they were household names. But more than the garments, it was the people behind them who fascinated her. Doris made it her mission to amplify and uplift the next generation of creative talent.

Her impact reached far beyond the runway. Doris was an activist at heart, using style as a platform for societal change. Dedicated to supporting diversity in her hometown and beyond, she integrated Black models into her runway shows during Boston's racial tensions, long before it was common practice. In her early days at Saks, she led large-scale awareness and advocacy efforts for The AIDS Action Committee. In more recent years, she made headlines in her support of Occupy Boston protesters and continued to lend her voice and energy to critical global issues of equality and justice.

Most importantly, Doris believed in young people. She adored their energy, their optimism, their ideas—often declaring that she was an octogenarian trapped in a 25 year old's body. She was more than a mentor; she was a true champion, spending countless hours encouraging, advising, and celebrating those forging their own paths. Doris was a provocateur, and a dazzling, unstoppable force. Her legacy shines on through every young designer who dares to dream big, push limits, and continue the work she pursued so passionately throughout her extraordinary life.
