Transfer institution: Massachusetts College of Art and Design (MassArt)

Summary of Benefits:

- Guaranteed acceptance pending portfolio review with a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Guaranteed transfer of 60 credits with a grade of C or higher
- Guaranteed MassTransfer benefits (tuition credit, waived application fee)
 - Students may also be eligible for Commonwealth Commitment benefits (freeze on tuition and fees, 10% semester rebate)
- Students transfer in at the junior level with two years of full time enrollment towards graduation
