The Godine Fellowship is awarded for exceptional merit in any college discipline to help defray the cost of traveling for the purpose of completing a well-defined project, the exhibition or publication of any work, or any project having artistic merit. The late Dr. Morton R. Godine had a long affiliation with the college serving both as Vice President of Administration and Finance and as a member of the college's Board of Trustees and the MassArt Foundation.

ACADEMIC HONORS

This honor is based solely on the grades a student received in Liberal Arts and History of Art courses at the college. Students in the graduating class are ranked by the number of A's they have received in these courses by the start of the spring semester of their senior year; the top 15% of students receive Academic Honors. At least seven Liberal Arts and/or History of Art courses must have been taken at MassArt for the student to be eligible for this honor.

GRADUATION WITH DISTINCTION

Graduation with Distinction is based solely on a student's grades. The student must have received at least six honors grades, including at least one each in a Liberal Arts or History of Art course and one in his or her area of concentration.
