MORTON R. GODINE FELLOWSHIP

The Godine Fellowship is awarded for exceptional merit in any college discipline to help defray the cost of traveling for the purpose of completing a well-defined project, the exhibition or publication of any work, or any project having artistic merit. The late Dr. Morton R. Godine had a long affiliation with the college serving both as Vice President of Administration and Finance and as a member of the college's Board of Trustees and the MassArt Foundation.

WARNER TRAVEL FELLOWSHIP

The Warner Fellowship is awarded to any student matriculating in any discipline offered by the college. The award is given to a rising senior to defray the cost of travel between the student's junior and senior years. The Fellowship is established by MassArt Foundation Board member Elissa Warner and her husband William with the intention of informing a well-defined project, the exhibition or publication of any work, or any project having artistic merit during the student's senior year.

ACADEMIC HONORS

This honor is based solely on the grades a student received in Liberal Arts and History of Art courses at the college. Students must have earned at least eight A's in these courses by the start of the spring semester of their senior year; at least seven of the courses must have been taken at MassArt for the student to be eligible for this honor.

DEPARTMENTAL HONORS

Departmental Honors are awarded to graduating students judged most exceptional by their departmental faculty.


