1. Strongly Recommended:

1a. External Hard drives

There are two kinds of hard drives in the world:

Those that are dead. Those that are about to die.

1 you keep at home, never move and back up all your stuff on everyday. 1 you travel with.

7200rpm only! on any hard drive never get anything else (5400rpm is BAD), other than Solid State.

DO NOT BUY 5400RPM DRIVES!

Solid State drives have no rpm or moving parts they are faster, but have lower capacity and are more expensive.

7200rpm refers to how fast the disc rotates in the hard drive, the faster the rotation the faster your access times are. 7200rpm is a minimum for moving image work.

Solid state is a new technology that has no moving parts and much faster access times, but they are more expensive for less capacity. They are the best.

USB3.0 or Thunderbolt connection is best. Having multiple connections is vital in case a port fails. You have another port to get your data off.

Hard drive health tips

Always eject your hard drive before unplugging from the computer otherwise you run the risk of corrupting your data.

Do not drop the hard drive!

Stay away from Lacie drives! I recommend Other World Computing, Seagate, Western Digital (check online reviews)
