

# TO BRING / NOT TO BRING

## WHAT DOES MASSART PROVIDE?

### ARTISTS' RESIDENCE

MassArt will provide a bed & mattress, bookcase, chair, desk, dresser, wardrobe, window shades, and overhead lighting. You may borrow a broom, dustpan/brush, or vacuum from maintenance staff.

The Artists' Residence also features full kitchens with a dishwasher, refrigerator, sink, and stove.

*Dimensions of the above furniture are available in the floorplans of their respective buildings.*

## WHAT SHOULD YOU BRING?

You should bring bathroom tissue, bed linen twin extra long, blanket or comforter, cleaning supplies, clothing hangers, cookware & dishes, desk lamp, mattress pad, pillows/cases, towels/washcloths, toiletries, and a wastebasket.

*Also consider: an alarm clock, pictures/posters (no nails or tacks), sewing kit, computer, personal items, rugs, laundry supplies, small refrigerator (4CL or less)*

## WHAT CAN'T YOU BRING?

**You cannot bring** air conditioners, candles, curtains, drug paraphernalia, halogen lamps, incense, pets/animals/fish, nails/screws/tacks for walls, outdoor antennas, sofa beds, waterbeds, or weapons of any kind.

## COMMUNICATION

Communicate with your future roommate and/or apartment-mates to try and coordinate what you bring for the common areas to avoid duplications of such items. We hope you enjoy living in the residence halls and encourage you to be active and involved. ## MICROWAVES
