Student Leadership at MassArt is rooted in MassArt's Mission and Values and is essential to transforming MassArt's culture and community. All student leaders will be expected to uphold MassArt's missions and values as we work together to make MassArt a more equitable place to work, learn, live and make.

OVERVIEW:

Artward Bound is a free 4-year program that prepares 9th - 12th-grade students interested in visual arts and design with the artistic and academic skills needed for admission to and success at an art/design college or other post-secondary institution.

Position Description:

Mentors are a mainstay of the Artward Bound program. The Mentor will support classroom instruction in both academics and art and general program activities focused on student engagement and support. As the programmatic focus is a balance between Art, Academics, and Life Skills, the Mentors' role in holistically supporting student success and growth is foundational to the program. Mentors may also help students with homework completion, assistance in time management, organizational, and study skills. The Mentor should be proactive and ready to provide support for students on an individual basis when need arises in art, academics or life skills needs become apparent. Student learning goals should address critical thinking, communication, perseverance and collaboration. The mentor is also expected to work with their instructor prior to each day's instruction to plan for the day and meet student needs.

Responsibilities:

- Assist academic and art classroom teachers with delivery of online curriculum content
- Support students on campus
- Provide individual student support as needed
- Take attendance, contact students and remind them of important dates/deadlines
- Provide positive social and emotional support and mentoring to students
- Assist with organizing, preparing, documenting and preparing for the final exhibition/reviews
- Participate in Staff Meetings and other professional development opportunities
- Support general program activities as needed

Qualifications:

- Must be in good academic and disciplinary standing
- Must have patience and a strong desire to help students achieve their goals
- Proficiency with Google Classroom, Zoom, Discord and other related online software
- Responsible, dependable, honest and mature
- Friendly, patient and sensitive to a diversity of students
