CREATIVE STUDIOS is a fun and challenging program for young artists who have a desire to expand their knowledge in the visual arts. Daily studio classes allow students to experience the rigor and excitement of art making by introducing techniques, skills and habits that are fundamental to successful work. For students of all abilities, Creative Studios classes span a range of disciplines and interests for younger artists.

Students may attend Creative Studios for the full day, or for morning or afternoon sessions only. Students choosing the full-day option may bring either a bagged lunch or money to purchase lunch at our cafeteria. Creative Studios staff supervise lunch hour.

STUDIO CHOICES

MORNING SESSIONS 8:30AM-12:00PM

Students have the option to attend a morning studio and/or an afternoon studio.

Architecture and Design

How do we express our ideas about the architecture that surrounds us? What would your dream house look like? This studio includes drawing exercises, structural building projects, exploratory field trips, and the basics of drafting and model building.

Drawing Fundamentals

Students learn new tools to develop their drawing skills and techniques while expanding their visual vocabulary. This class covers basics of linear and aerial perspective, as well as a number of traditional and less conventional approaches to composition and drawing.

Fashion Design

Learn how a piece is created from concept to drawing to construction. Students will translate creative designs into finished garments.

Stop Motion Animation

This studio introduces basic principles of stop motion animation through an exploration of different media and storytelling techniques. Students gain exposure to various contemporary animators and artists. Class time will be spent working in groups and on individual projects.

SUMMER 2020

AFTERNOON SESSIONS 1:00PM-4:30PM

Students have the option to attend a morning studio and/or an afternoon studio.

Comic Book Art

This studio class focuses on the art of sequential comics. Learn how to translate sketches into clear, dynamic and entertaining comics. Focus on story structure and style, and find your own voice in the ever-changing world of comic art.

Painting Fundamentals

Using acrylic paint, students learn foundational painting techniques. Working from observation, explore composition, color, tone, and line and develop skills in mixing colors.

Studio Explorations

Draw, paint and sculpt from the clothed figure, the still life, and from imagination. Visits to neighboring museums and galleries provide inspiration and emphasize the connections between students' artwork and exhibited art. Students will discuss and develop composition and design techniques while building their body of work.

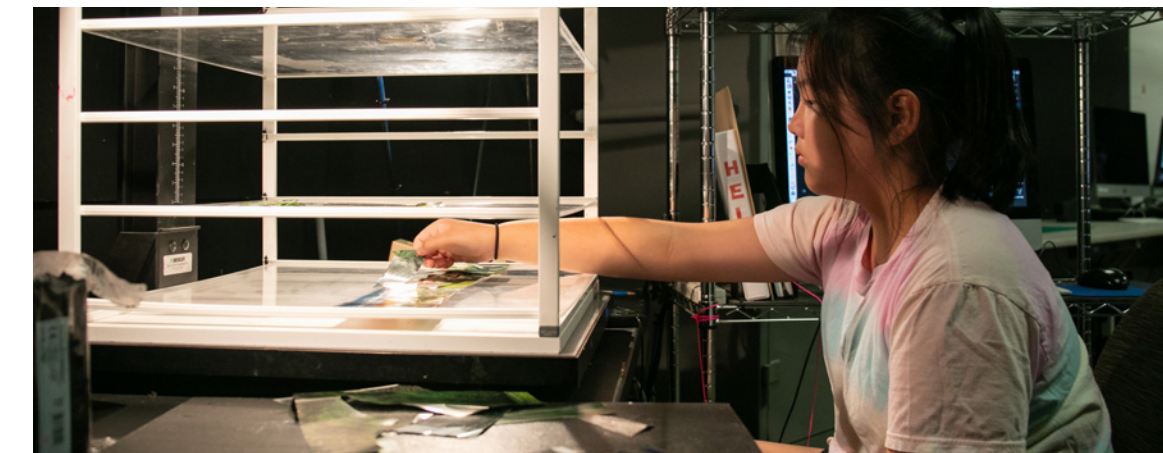
A \$100 non-refundable deposit must be sent upon confirmation of class placement.
