STUDENT LEADERSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. Review this process and be cognizant of the application timeline
- 2. Attend an Information Session: Tuesday, 12/5 at 7pm in Smith Hall; Thursday, 12/7 in Treehouse; Friday, 12/8 at 3:30pm in Huntington Studio, 3rd Floor DMC
- 3. Review the job descriptions online and apply via the online application (this will require you to upload a resume so have that ready!)

4. Sign up for an interview:

All new and returning candidates are required to interview for each position that they have applied for with the respective hiring manager/team (15-30 minute interviews). You will receive instructions about signing up for interviews in January.

5. Attend Group Process Day on February 24 2018.

For some of the leadership positions it is required that applicants attend Group Process Day. At this one-day workshop you will meet other student leadership candidates and the hiring managers for the leadership positions. The day includes team-building exercises where you will be able to showcase your leadership skills and your ability to work with others. Hiring managers will be present to observe and determine which students best fit the requirements of their positions.
