

Are you a college student who is homeless or worried that you might become homeless?

Affordable Housing Opportunity Available

Kaszanek House (K-House) College Scholars Program is an affordable year-round off-campus living and learning community for college students who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless. Students from the following colleges are eligible:

- Bunker Hill Community College
- Roxbury Community College
- Massachusetts College of Art and Design
- University of Massachusetts Boston

What: K-House is an 11-unit Single Room Occupancy building in Malden, Massachusetts.

Each tenant has a single, private room furnished with a bed and dresser. There is a shared:

- Kitchen, dining room
- 6 bathrooms (Tenants share with 1-2 others)
- Community room
- Laundry Room
- Study Room
- Back yard patio

One unit and all common areas are accessible.

Where: In Malden, a short walk to the Malden Center MBTA Orange line stop, adjacent to bike path, 1-2 blocks to pharmacies, supermarket, and Malden Center.

How much does it cost?

Rent is subsidized, which means you will pay 30% of your income for rent. You will apply for a housing subsidy, which will cover the rest of your rent payment.

To be eligible for housing at Kaszanek House, you must:

- Be homeless or at risk of becoming homeless
- Be a college student in good standing enrolled in a 2- or 4- year degree program at one of the four colleges
- Apply and be found eligible to receive a Metro Housing Boston housing subsidy
