What is SGA?

Student Government Association (SGA) exists to encourage responsible Student Activism through Self-Governance. As the Representative unit of the Student body, we secure and defend our right to full participation in the process of decision making which affects our education and educational environment.

What is Full Council?

All MassArt students are members of our organization. Everyone is welcome to attend to any weekly Full Council meetings; we meet on Wednesdays at 1:30pm in Kennedy 280. The Full Council is made up of one representative from every department on campus as well as one representative from every SGA recognized student organization.

What does the E-board do?

SGA Full Council is led by the SGA Executive Board. Executive Board members ideate, collaborate, and liaise between students and administrators to bring new initiatives to fruition and create change at MassArt.

Executive Board Positions:

President:

- The President oversees the full council meetings on the Wednesday meeting times from 1:30-3.
- Responsible for delegating tasks among the E-board and makes sure everyone is on task.
- The President must be proactive in their leadership on the campus.
- The President is required to attend bi-weekly meetings for the All University Committee

Vice President:

- Assists students with engaging in the MassArt community by hearing them out and interacting beyond SGA.
- Steps in for the President when they are unavailable at Full Council meetings as the moderator
- The Vice President is responsible for organizing the entire All School Show every Spring semester, which is the annual show that each department participates in and curates their own best work

Secretary:

- Tracks attendence of all Full Council members
- Schedules all meetings and speakers for Full Council
- Responsible for Taking minutes at weekly board meetings as well as Full Council Meetings

Student Trustee:

- Serves as the liaison between the Student body and the Board of Trustees, the decision-making body at the top of MassArt's governance structure.
- The Student Trustee attends monthly Board and subcommittee meetings and has the full responsibilities and voting privileges of a MassArt Trustee.
- Must communicate with the MassArt to understand and effectively represent the student voice

Treasurer:

- Responsible for managing all budget allocation and spending of student groups and departments within SGA
- Leads the budget submission and allocation process, with budget committee, which happens once a semester
- Responsible for processing any paperwork regarding spending requests and updating our Online budget records

Media Coordinator:

- Manages all of SGA's social media handles.
 (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter)
- Works with the Marketing department to upkeep SGA page on the school's website
- Responsible for coming up with SGA Merchandise
