March 1:
FAFSA

☐ The FAFSA Priority Deadline.

April 1:
Scholarship Appeal

☐ Scholarship Appeals: Appeals must be submitted via the form available in your application portal.

May 1:
Offer Reply Form
Tuition Deposit
Housing Deposit
Housing Application
Request for Accommodations

☐ Offer Reply Form: Accept or decline offer of admission.
☐ \$550 Tuition Deposit: Secures a place as a student in the incoming class.
☐ \$450 Housing Deposit: Reserves a space in on-campus housing.
☐ Housing Application for on-campus housing.
☐ Request for Accommodation Form: Students with documented disabilities can receive accommodations in and outside the classroom.

June 1:
Student Questionnaire
(Transfer students only)

☐ Student Schedule Questionnaire: The Registrar will take into consideration, when possible, your existing schedule and commute to campus when building your schedule.

Late June:
Health Insurance

☐ Enroll in OR Waive health insurance.

June 30:
Immunizations
Final Transcripts

☐ Immunizations: Incoming students must submit the MassArt Immunization Record Form, completed and signed by a physician.
☐ Submit final transcripts of your most recently attended school(s).

July 1:
Request For Accommodations
(Classroom Accommodations)

☐ Request for Accommodation Form: Students with documented disabilities can receive accommodations in and outside the classroom.

July:
Tuition Bills Released
Class Schedules Created

☐ Business Office releases Fall semester tuition bills. Tuition bills can be paid on the Self Service Portal.
☐ Registrar will begin building Fall semester schedules. All incoming students are pre-registered for their first semester classes.

Early August:
Tuition Bills Due

☐ Tuition bills: Bills must be paid in full to prevent delays in enrollment and move-in.
