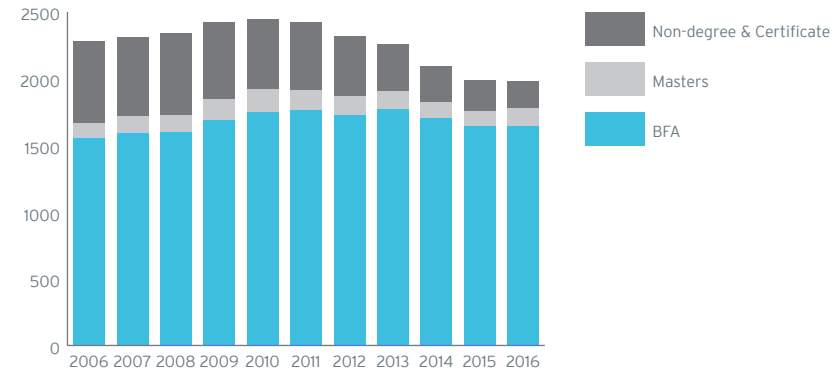

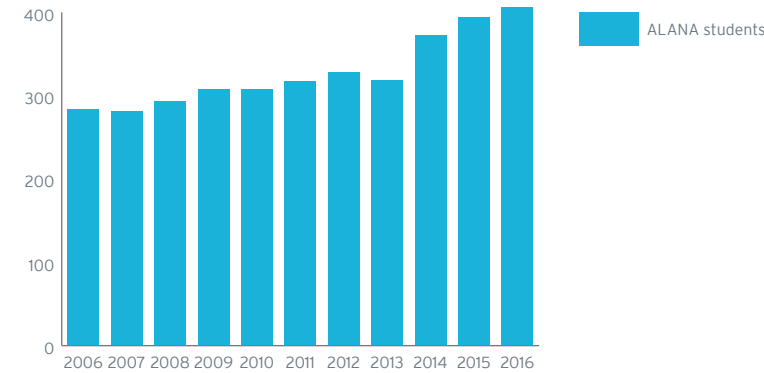

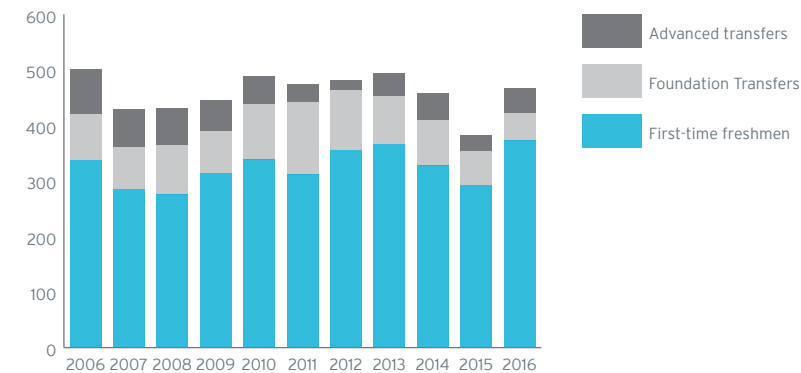
Enrollment by Degree Program
